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
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What's New

Tips for Summer Home Maintenance

Spring is in full force, and summer is nearly upon us! Here are some tips for maintaining your home.

Reverse the direction of your ceiling fans. If your fans spin counterclockwise, it'll push the air straight down and keep your home nice and cool. To do this, turn off the fan, wait for it to stop, and change the direction switch.

Detectors

Test your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors

and replace batteries if needed.

Cooling Systems

With the 2023 El Niño predicted to bring warmer than usual termperatures, be sure to properly maintain your A/C units and fans.

Drver Vents

Clean out all of the dust and lint trapped in your dryer vent and exhaust duct. Call in a professional to clean and service your washer and dryer if needed. Dryers can be a fire hazard if they're not cleaned and maintained.



Grills

For charcoal grills, empty the grill and wipe away any dust or residue. Use hot water, dish soap, and a scrub brush or sponge to clean the outside and inside of the grill. For gas grills, close the lid, turn the heat up high, and let the grill cook for about 30 minutes. Let the grill cool, then use a grill brush to sweep the grill. Wipe down the outside with a sponge and cleaner, then clean out all drip trays.
